"I am ready to do anything to defend my beliefs."

"I am not going to lose this fight."

"What does that mean for you?"

"I want someone working with me who advances the same beliefs as mine."

"Will that be enough?"

"You have been here before."

"What do you ant me to say to protect my beliefs?"

"I have one person who is willing to do what is necessary to change."

"You do a job, and it is totally hell. You live in a shitty house. The roof is leaking. The heat is not working. There are rats. There is no hope that you will get a raise. You got your job through the help of friends. Your skills are not transferrable. If you went

somewhere else, you would get paid less."

"Why do you expect society to solve those problems?"

"There are so many people who suffer like that. A few changes will not be enough. The overall system has to change. There are ways to create beneficial situations for all people. There are so many people with unused skills. Productivity is held down to protect the few."

"Were you even prepared for what was going to happen?"

"I came to Revolutionary Aims for a reason."

"We can come to your place. We can survey what is happening. We can do our best to help out."

"I do not like your face. I do not like how this is happening."

"Am I supposed to be your match? What is bothering you?"

"I cannot let this bother me."

"You want me to get involved with your dating service. How do I sign up?"

"We have some questions. Why do you feel in conflict with the society?"

"People have said nasty things to me. They do not believe that I have abilities. I am studying to be a nurse. I have brains. But they mock my abilities. I see this as a societal problem. I can do what I can to better my lot."

"But there are social impediments to my advancement."

"Life is not fair."

"I can meet the challenges in my life. However, there are impediments that are nearly impossible to overcome. Due to my social commitment, I have been able to overcome those limiting factors. But there things that seem permanent. I cannot do anything about that."

"Would you like to learn more? Or do you want to sign up?"

"I want to play."

"You do realize that there are risks. You need to be willing to meet these risks."

"What are the actual risks?"

"Do yo have problems trusting people?"

"I have immense problems. I am not sure what others want of me. I think that they recognize my vulnerability, and they think that they can take advantage of me. I don't want to come off as weak."

"Do what you have to if you want to survive?"

"I was told that these questions would help fortify my ego. I could discover the skills to resist emotional intrusion. I could make friends with people who respected my beliefs."

"Are you searching for more?"

"What does that mean?"

"Where do you come in?"

"Someone told me to join up."

"There comes a point when you have to make your own decisions."

"I know what I like on pizza."

"That is really a beginning."

"This will not last that long."

"There are a lot of things which I do not understand."

"Are you looking for an explanation?"

"If you change the questions and answers, you can exercise a great deal of power over

this experience."

- "Are you asking if I can manipulate your behavior?"
- "I am not looking for that."
- "But you are wondering if that is possible."
- "I have a lot of questions."
- "How can I reassure you?"
- "This is a matter of your self-knowledge. Are you going to say thing that are going to betray who you are?"
 - "This was not supposed to have any effect."
 - "What do you want to happen with your life?"
 - "Do you want to stay like this forever?"
 - "I have a bigger dream."
- "There is a mystery to all of this. Are you willing to inquire. Do you like how things are happening for you?"
 - "What does that mean?"

 - "Is this a question for my profile. Or are you asking me a psychological question?"
 - "Why would I ask psychological questions?"
 - "Maybe, you want to help me. Or you want to use me in some weird way."
 - "I am not trying to experiment on you in any weird way."
- "This is an experiment. You use the information to manipulate the dating pool. You could just as easily use the information to influence how I act."
 - "Do you want me to help you?"
 - "How would you do that?"
- "You seem to imply that I have a problem. Maybe, you could direct me in a way that I would find reward in a more pleasant way."
 - "The rat in the maze."
 - "The wild rat in the wilder dating maze."
- "There is a point when I could offer you benefits which might improve your ability to play."
 - "This is more of a game than service."
 - "What do you want it to be?"
 - "I felt that you had something to assist me in the ways that I think about myself."
 - "How deep can you get into this?"
 - "You are going to have to make some real changes."
 - "What are you telling me?"
- "Do I know who I really am? What kinds of things are distracting me from who I am?"
- "Are you saying this to me? Or are you telling me that people end up saying these things about each other."
 - "Where are your crosses? Do you know the source of your suffering?"
- "I suffer because I have personal doubts in myself. I feel as if my youth is being used against me. But I do not feel that young anymore."
 - "How can I help you?"

- "Maybe, you can find me a guy who will respect me for my integrity."
- "I can do my best. But you have to do your part."
- "How am I supposed to do that?"
- "Give the right answers to the following questions."
- "Ask away!"
- "What if you cannot do it anymore?"
- "I have my work. I do not put that much pressure on the other person?"
- "I can tell. Do you realize that your work is destroying you?"
- "This is Revolutionary Aims. I thought that this was the situation for all of us."
- "I am not trying to mock your life. But you have your own concrete situation."
- "Lia, do you want dates, or do you want to change the world? Or do you want to change th world so that you can have dates?
 - "Are you mocking me?"
 - "Why do you suggest that?"
 - "Where do you live?"
 - "I have my own apartment."
- "Lia, I am not sure if this discussion will have great appeal for you. You may find more affinity with the associated from Revolutionary Aims. However, there are deeper questions about the political role of the writer. You may want to participate in this discussion. The writer cannot accommodate with the actions of the dominant culture. Although the individual has attained an understanding of her place in the society, the writer is in a unique place since she can avoid the pressures exercised by her bosses. She can recognize the effects of her economic isolation. But she can use her understanding to resist the cruel effects of her life."
- "If the writer only submits to these pressures, then she is looking for an accommodation. She can create an image of the society which makes the oppressors appear to be liberators. Or the liberators can have oppressive tendencies, and she is not willing to declare these beliefs."
 - "Where does this come from?"
- "If you do not seek to surpass the terms of survival, then you risk becoming a collaborator."
 - "But the survival mentality can create its own risks."
 - "What are you trying to tell me?"
 - "Chase the animals!"
 - "Will I find my liberation?"
 - "What is that?"
- "What is going on Lia? Are you loved? Or are you trying to escape your fundamental entrapment?"
 - "How are you trapped?"
 - "I have become myself too much."
 - "What does that mean?"
 - "We are all trapped."
 - "That is nonsense. We have to take a stand."
 - "Are you telling me to date by Revolutionary Aims?"

- "Are you all working together?"
- "Who is left?"
- "Lia, are you going to eat a revolutionary meal?"

"I think that I need to do more than make lifestyle changes. I am experiencing a challenging life. I have felt stigmatized by the society. My ideas have not been respected. If I relied on my youth and my cuteness, I could attain limited advancement. But that would never be permanent. I would sense the crushing forces of my job. She works to ally herself with a workers- based movement. She strives to remind them of the historical betrayals of the workers and to demonstrate that an actual revolution is the only way to overcome the contradictions of the economic system. They are the forces."

"Authoritarian leftist thought is still right wing in trajectory it holds on to power and does not yield to the incipient power of the working class."

Étienne had been a witness. And his testimony had changed over the years. He had never participated, but he knew what he was supposed to have seen. After four or five years, his memories mixed with his desires. After ten or fifteen years, he corrected his recollection to serve his present aspirations. After twenty years, his regrets clouded his reconstruction of the events. All along, he wanted to believe that his attitude offered an important contribution to what had actually occurred.

"This was one of the most important events in world history. For a few days, the streets of Paris were alive with committed revolutionaries, who had the power to alter the trajectory of planet."

"And you were at the center of the action."

Étienne spent his years trying to verify every aspect of the insurrection. That made him appear to be more involved. Only an actual player could have such intimate knowledge of he events. The streets seemed to quake with the movement of the students. They were being chased by the police. They felt that their actions were strategic.

"They eventually closed Cluny métro spot because the authorities believed that it served as an organizing point for the revolution. Students could easily navigated from one site to another. They believed that there numbers seemed more enormous. This posed a threat to the government's forces."

Did this game of cat and mouse actually serve to propel the movement? Étienne's description added to the romantic impact of the event. I felt that I was being called to my destiny. Paris '68 was something unique. None of us had wandered the streets of Philadelphia when the rang the bell of liberty. We were not around for the storming of the Bastille. There were only a handful of survivors of the October Revolution. But Étienne had been there for the big one.

If you walked along the Boul Mich, you could still see the bullet holes left from skirmishes with the Gestapo. But I still believed that I could touch the ghosts of '68. Maybe, I would never venture to France. But Étienne was making me excited.

"It wasn't just the political awareness. These were cultural changes. They went beyond the existentialism of Sartre. It was a new way of thinking about language."

He was revealing a special code. I wanted to learn it.

"This is difficult to figure out."

I heard someone else explain it."

"You can use systems theory to explain duty in Corneille."

"There is a systemic disturbance. And the organic mechanism work to repair the damage to the system. The state returns the public confusion to the assertion of authority."

"This seems like a reactionary perspective."

"The revolutionary is the real protector of the ethical order. He recognizes that the king has sullied the social compact."

I wondered what would happen if you balanced these views of Corneille with those of Étienne. This seemed like a marvelous revolutionary synthesis. But Étienne did not have that

same commitment to political change. He talked a good game. I imagined myself at the front of the barricades.

When I saw him years later, he did not maintain the same zeal. Perhaps, he had been in the States too long. He had become a victim of consumerism. I wondered if there was any accuracy to his portrayal. Perhaps, there was someone else who could serve as a better witness.

Was it my role to find a better witness, or was I supposed to create a more appealing version of these events? Had I somehow become the new witness. What was I supposed to share? I had made a commitment to the event. We continued to commemorate the effectiveness of the rebellion. But something remained unfulfilled. Everyone pointed fingers.

The Stalinist CP was the first culprit. There is little doubt that they sabotaged the aspirations of French workers. Their role was to be expected. Few of the revolutionaries believed that the CP could offer sufficient leadership.

The revolutionaries were the students. They had drawn their principles from Trotsky, so they attempted to defer to the needs of the workers. But they became caught up in the antics of revolution. It was not that they underestimated their power. They preferred to play games with the police instead of showing the necessary political commitment. They still believed that they were the source of political power. They did not recognize how the workers had the power to overthrow the De Gaulle government. In that mistake, they destroyed an critical opportunity for political change. The workers were already taking possession of the factories. But the student leadership allowed the right wing reaction of the government to solidify. The radical moment was dismantled.

I thought that I had a clarity. Étienne had never been the figure that he sold himself as. This was a revolution of spectators. Everyone could claim that he had taken part. But none had provided he leadership to progress to the next stage.

In a retelling of the tale, they were all important. History was not there to deny their importance. There had been no storming of the palace. Lenin had not stood at the head of the crowd. As the participants reflected back on the event, they tended to minimize the threat, which they posed. They made it seem as if they were eloquent figures in the drama. But they all wanted to advance in the power structure. So they were committed to an indispensable contradiction. The theater was apparent.

Étienne had interested me in this inevitable struggle. I wanted to find a way to become more involved. Maybe I could develop a more articulate role in the classroom. Or maybe I could leave school and start my own educational program. I could close myself off in the stacks and read all the pertinent books to recreate the experience.

I already had a glimpse. I was convince that there was more. Novelists and poets had chronicled these skirmishes. There were films which sought to capture the excitment.

"So what were you doing in 1968?"

"What kind of question are you asking me."

"You see yourself as a radical voice. So what were you doing when the revolution needed you."

"I am a film maker. I film events. I do not create them. I am not even sure that this was a revolution."

"What happens after your revolution?"

- "The great thinkers of our time. The ones who provide the social motivation for political events."
 - "Are you looking for someone to blame?"
- "I have some questions to ask. Do you think that the constitution of a vanguard party only hampers the development of a political revolt?"
- "Why are you still talking like this? We have surpassed the limited ways of talking which stood in the way of real social progress."
- "What is progress? Being a super freak, or a member of a green revolution? You betrayed the revolution, and you are making excuses for your turn inward."
- "This is the beginning and end of your revolution. You do not want to progress. You just want to impose your totemic order."
 - "I am not as backwards as you make me."
 - "What do you want me to do? I can occupy the bathroom and refuse to come out."
 - "Is that a personal act or a personal act?"
 - "Why are you such a prick?"
 - "That is how you are trying to cast me in your drama."
 - "We came together."
 - "You are really comfortable."
 - "I am so incomplete."
 - "Only you can make me complete!"
 - "You are such a prick."
- "In 2018, is it possible to achieve a revolutionary pose? You are observing people who had an historical context for change. Where is your foundation? You romanticize events in which you did not participate. And you act as if these events can occur again."
- "Is this a virtual experience? Am I going to find people with whom I can play revolution?"
- "I really want to know if this is some kind of CIA plot. Are you trying to get people to express their radicalism. This will enable their prosecution and imprisonment."
- "I am really doing nothing wrong. I am observing the progress of history. If you don't like my predictions, then that is your problem."
- "Here is out great fear. These predictions will serve as blueprint for social radicalism. Impressionable individuals will feel as if they are being invited to participate in an incipient revolt."
 - "How can I help? How can I become an active participant in the coming rebellion?"
 - "This is potluck. You can bring a dish."
 - "This seems like a hopeless distortion of history."
 - "I am good at this!"
- "Do you recognize your mistakes? You have taken history and distorted it for your own benefits. The events of '68 were indeed a worthy inspiration for something greater. But exaggerated your own role. And that act has destroyed the real potential for political change."

"I was your teacher. I was giving you a road map. You could travel down any path which appealed to you."

"You were making your aspirations seem more essential to the actual events. You wanted to make us believe that you understood something important about the social experience."

"I was part of that experience. It happened over time. It was not like a show with a start time and an usher to show you to your seat."

"You are mocking your shortcomings. This is not about our actual role at the time. How did you engage in self-reflection about those events? Did your study permit you to adopt a critical attitude?"

"Do you want me to blame myself? Isn't that your problem when you review the past? You are always looking to blame someone. Your expectations are too great. No one has the time to be the kind of person who you want them to be. We have a job. We have friends and family."

"You were the one who built up this great event. It was supposed to lead to a profound social experience."

"What do you want me to say? I was young."

"You were my teacher. You wanted me to think about the world in a special way. Now you are telling me not to worry about it. Those who can't do, teach."

"Why are you mocking me, Steven. I am not your father. Even your father was not the man who you think that he was."

Étienne, you are so weak."

"My kids love me."

"What else is there?"

"What else is there?"

"What else is there?"

"He wanted things from me. I could not give him what he needed or wanted."

"There is a secret logic to this."

"Is this a moral tale."

"It is still getting started."

"At least someone can end the confusion."

"I was married to him for a while. Whenever I expressed my concerns, he would tell me that life is more casual. You just have to take things as they come to you. He was an embarrassment. I am glad that I did not give more of myself to him."

"What does that mean, more of yourself?"

"You need to understand how I am trying to explain this. We shared things about each other. But he was not a supportive lover. He would take without giving. I realized that. But I stayed with him. I tried not let it bother me."

I did not want to suggest that Étienne's personal problems were the sole criterion for questioning his political beliefs. But he was unable to resolve a fundamental historical contradiction. I was not sure how I was going to work my way through these difficulties. I had not invested too much in this vision. He wasn't just a teacher. He had been influential in my development. If I expected more from him, it went with the territory.

"Don't you have anyone else that you can blame? That seems to be your strong suit."

"Why can't you admit that you were not that great of a teacher?"

"What were you expecting? I was not teaching particle theory."

"I want something that I can be happy about. You were part of a great event. But it revealed you to be a bit of a fraud. How else an I explain it?"

"I never claimed to be anything more than I was."

"You had this attitude. I felt so inspired."

"You have a tendency to put too much faith in other people."

"I put a lot of faith in myself. I want to make a difference. I do not want to simply watch the flow of time."

"You are drowning in the flow of time."

"I have something great to share with the world. If no one realizes what I can contribute here, I can find somewhere else to go."

"You are making me feel as if you are interfering in a soufflé. Close the damn oven."

"This is a recipe book."

"Steven, I do not want to disappoint you. I am a very ordinary person. There is no secret parts to my existence."

"This is very important."

"I feel as if I really understand."

"What does this mean?"

"I am searching for someone important. And it you are not that person, so be it."

"We are all important in our own way."

"Someone is going to break from the group and realize that there is more to the story."

"And who is that person, Steven."

"I don't think that it is you. Honestly, I know that it is not you. Let's be honest. You wanted it to be you. People treated you well because you exuded this charm. But you were ordinary."

"And what are you willing to share?"

"What are you willing to share?"

"This is getting explosive."

"What can I hope to tell you to reassure you? These are things which really bother me.

These are things which I think are going to destroy me."

"I never see what I expect to see. There was too much glare. I became too attached to a belief that I was the center of something important."

"You were the center of something important. But you attributed the effect to your ego. It had nothing to do with your background. You had stumbled upon a unique social connection. And you could offer the necessary dynamic. What did you end up doing? You saw it as all related to the self. When that didn't work out, you felt that we all needed special psychological programs to offer power to our character. You were weak when it mattered. Your strengthe is not going to provide any sort of personal gratification."

"We cannot go back in time and change things. These events have already taken place. I can only prepare for what is going to transpire in the future."

"And what could that be? There is no future if you are not honest about your past."

"How am I going to do that?"

"And what is your part in this?"

"You need to be more assertive when you have the opportunity. You hvae to act out thes events in your mind. This time, find the courage."

"I am doing my best."

"I wrote this book about finding courage. Other people told me that I offered them necessary guidance. I could not have been happier."

"Is that all that you have to say? Doesn't our mathematical knowledge invite you to think in a different way about experience."

"Yeah, that makes me a math teach."

"There is no possibility of a greater social experience."

"I am not a shaman. I can only give you what I know. I expected too much from myself. And I was impatient. I have realized that was not the correct course."

"You had Vietnam."

"And I realized that I did not want to sympathize with a totalitarian regime."

"The United States practiced genocide."

"American died."

"That became an excuse to slaughter people."

"I am not a bleeding heart. We were both wrong."

"So you deny the crimes of this country."

"Some people did some terrible things. But we did not use the best means to oppose

"Perhaps we needed to have a truth commission. If you are not going to accept the responsibility for what happened, that is your right. But that does not diminish all the atrocious things that were done."

"I am sympathetic. But there is nothing more that I can do. I am a teacher. I do my job. I don't think that I should quit doing that so I can make amends for something which has nothing to do with me."

"I do not want to end up in the same place."

"There are loads of people who could have done a better job."

"There is no other way to cast this."

"What does that mean?"

"Sometimes, you should not complain."

"Are we going to have to go over the record."

"We have the killing by the North. There is Cambodia. There is enough blame to go around."

"The Kmer Rouge were facilitated by the US bombing campaign. French oppression created the circumstances to eliminate the revolutionary leadership in the South. Your perspective of radicalism was an extension of the Stalinism that destroyed the Saigon Left. And those kinds of beliefs enable you to jump ship and become a careerist."

"Do I have to hear this for the rest of my life. I am not a Wall Street banker?"

"You needed to do more at the moment."

"Are you going around to everyone and ringing the morality bell. A lot of good that is going to do the world."

"This is worse than I thought it would be."

"What is your defense?"

"I don't need one."

"That is how you washed your hands."

"See these hands, there is no blood on them."

"I am glad that you are clean."

"This is going to get better."

"I am glad that you are clean."

"I cannot make this go away in a few minutes."

"No more yes. What are you going to do about it?"

"I am going to call history, and they are going to takeme off the list."

"I get any closer, and I am going to scream."

"How did history get so screwed up."

"People did not pay their debts."

"What is the bitter taste?"

"History!"

"This is the best part."

- "Why did you take that course?"
- "I saw the way that things were going. I felt that I had no choice."
- "You invited others to go the same way."
- "You seized the moment. But there was no basis for your decision. You acted as if all this just happened."
 - "Do you really think that anyone can learn from your experience?"
 - "Are you going to go along just to get along."
 - "What do you want from me?"
 - "I want blood. But my friend wants a pound of flesh."
 - "Do you want me to be contrite? I am."
 - "You needed to take steps."
 - "I gave them what they wanted."
 - "I am a CEO for social change. Isn't that your new act?"

- "We are going to get our machine guns and go dancing. The romanticization of violence made it impossible for the movement to mobilize a more effective opposition to the dominant powers."
 - "What is dominant powers?"
 - "The economic system."
 - "I think that I trusted something that you offered."
 - "You trusted too much. We were not as radical as we should have been."
 - "This is awful."
 - "I am hearing squeaking."
 - "Squeaking and squawking."
- "There was this individual. Some Howard, and he recognized that changes needed to be made. But he turned it all into a personal thrill."

 - "You are looking at this!"
 - "Are you saying that we were not good leaders?"
 - "What difference did your leadership make?"
 - "We brought the system to its needs."
- "You destroyed any foundation for opposing the system. And your memories are doing more of the same today."
 - "We were wrong."
- "You were never right so you could have never been wrong. You were all wrong. If only you had a time of right."
 - "We were in opposition to something which was wrong."
 - "But you reinforced loyalty to something which was really wrong."
 - "SHUT THE FUCK UP!"
 - "Are you willing to listen to what I have to say?"
 - "Are you willing to listen. Where did you start being full of shit?"
 - "Why are you so intolerant."
 - "I wanted to be tolerant. I gave too much of myself to you."
 - "We are going home right now."

- "Let me explain myself."
- "I thought of you as a teacher."
- "I am a teacher."
- "You were playing game. Revolutionary ball. And when it was all over, you claimed that you were never a part of it."
- "We can do it all over. We can have a consolation round. We can put you all in a room and let you go at it again."
 - "Did you not like the way that I taught math?"
 - "I wasn't that kind of teacher."
 - "That the preponderance of evidence pointed to a social change."
 - "I wasn't that kind of teacher."
 - "I am seeing different kinds of experience."
 - "I wasn't that kind of teacher."
 - "What kind then?"
- "The working man is watching stupid television. Gilligan reassures him that the society will reward him."
 - "This is now your view, now. Were you able to predict myself."
 - "I was at the center of something real!"
 - "Suburban happiness."
 - "I live in a small town."
 - "I have journeyed to see you."
 - "This is your last chance."
 - "You cannot always have what you want."
 - "This is going to be good."
 - "I want the watch."
 - "Only by disobeying the law could we provide the basis for a new law."
 - "You embraced petty crime."
 - "You are even creepier."
 - "It is time to get rid of the leadership"

"LET ME TELL YOU WHO I REALLY AM! I HAVE GREAT DREAMS FOR MYSELF!"

- "Your success depends on you working with other people."
- "How do I do that?"
- "Fill out a questionnaire, and we can find someone who is perfect for you."
- "The computer tells you who is rigt for you."
- "The world tells you who is right for you."
- "I need to tell you who is going to be the hero of your story."
- "I thought it was me. Then it was person who I loved. Then the person who I loved made a mistake and loved someone else. And I did what I could to become that person."
 - "You needed to write a lot more."

I met someone with a better story than mine. She had a facility with words. Are you someone who I can trust. I want to share some of my best ideas. I don't want to hate myself."

"The working class is mesmerized by television and consumerism. We have to make

common cause with the Third World!"

- "On what basis? Do you want to inspire a popular uprising, or are you going to inspire a privileged layer to take over."
- "You have such fashion sense. Can you provide the necessary social changes for my life?"
 - "I do not want to get involved."
- "I believed your story about the demobilization of the working class. But it is not factual. When the union leadership is collaborating with the management, workers are only going to get more screwed.
 - "Freaks are revolutionaries too."
- "Only if they make common cause with an actual social revolution. Otherwise, there will be a freak buyout."
 - "There are multiples buyouts of you reality. Who is going to buy you out?"
 - "I have go to work. I have to map it out."
 - "I am so far out here."
 - "You are going to need a book to explain how wonderful you are."
 - "You have fifteen minutes to make history."
 - "I have heard all the stories."
 - "How he cried on television."
 - "I will not cry for people who are more messed up than I am."
 - "There is a truth here."
 - "HOWARD, when do I get free."
 - "Howard, I do not want to believe your shit."
 - "I have a picture of what I want."
 - "Revolutionary Aims will give you a book to go along with your love!"
 - "A picture is worth a thousand words."
 - "I can compromise."
 - "This is more than I can take."
 - "That is too close to me."
 - "Time for you all to leave."

I had thought about Howard's leadership as inspiration. He realized the pertinent issues. And he had unique moment to realize his vision. I had seem stories about him on television. The whole world had been watching.

People work all their lives for such rewards. Howard offered his own assessment of the situation. He seemed to rise above the crowd. He had seen similar actions in other part of the world. And the revolutionary potential was massive.

Howard's analysis had seemed accurate. He professed a great sensibility about the community. I did what I could to understand his reasoning. These were radical steps. They represented a break from the norm.

I felt that I was on the front lines. The fuse had been set. There was provocation after provocation. The leadership needed to understand what were the flash points.

It all seemed to make sense. A revolution started when the dominant power started to face significant opposition to its tyrannical powers.

"They key action was not adopt the policies of the enemy."

That may have been Howard's philosophy. But he started to apply his own strategies to the development of the movement. It all looked courageous and impressive. His associates felt that they were confronting the most ruthless military machine, whose cultural apparatuses served to advance violence. When there was such a disregard for human life, the organizers believed that force needed to be opposed with force. This was a total abstraction from the situation. The analysis was unable to account for the actual source of social deprivation. And the logic only cooperated with the oppressor.

If cruelty was a product of a deranged system, then the solution was not to carry out more cruel policies. Howard constantly threw around the word revolution. And he claimed that he was acting in the interest of working people. But there was no effort to involve working people. Criminal activity could never be the foundation of a political movement. But Howard believed that the power structure had lulled the people into conformity. Only a revolutionary movement could unleash all the hidden power stored up in the system.

Howard believed that he was leading the real working class. Only people who would respond to his radical invocations could be considered to be authentic. The working class needed to commit to this amorphous revolution. Howard's actions seemed to advance these ideas.

It really looked as if this was a rallying point for something bigger. The more that he advanced his beliefs, the more that they became out of touch with anything real. He was totally committed to his own illusions. But he did everything that he could to make it all seem more dramatic than ever.

It was almost as if Howard was performing for a television audience. And he was developing his own PR campaign. He was playing to his own audience. He wanted to be more of a Public Enemy than a political leader.

He was just beginning to perfect politics as theater. Even though he may have criticized the economic system and its commodity obsessions, he was taking a page from advertising. Even if the revolutionary event had no real effectiveness, it could attract a sizable audience. Perhaps, he thought that his notoriety would prove that he was fearless.

Howard created an imaginary enemy. As much as his actual opponents were able to dent his reputation, his inflated image enabled him to gain more adherents. It was almost as if his followers were impressed by his bravado. Even still, they were able to distill his reputation into something heroic. Those whom he did not win over appeared to be lost in the machinations of war machine. They may not have been willing participants. But he was able to dismiss their resistance to his appeals. That was all that mattered.

Howard only created more confusion. He may have started from the right place. But he ended up going lost in his own magic. That created more confusion. This was all the little red book and Bonnie and Clyde. Howard was trying out for the part of the antihero. He seemed almost brilliant.

From these efforts, Howard was able to suggest a whole revolutionary practice. His so-called manifestoes were gibberish. Everything was exaggerated and in broad strokes. But he held the attention of the world for a few days. With that commitment, he might have been able to devise something more significant. I was only watching him at play. That was hardly enough for the world. For the naive, like I, Howard seemed to be pointing the way to a great revelation. I put together the pieces which he left out.

I assumed that there was a whole volume, which could explain any questions not answered by Howard's speeches. Did that do the job? I could only hope that it did. Any other questions would have to be answered in practice. I felt that Howard had given me the tools to accomplish political change."

"There becomes a point where you have to seize the means of production."

Who else was following Howard's lead? Why would they? He was more convinced that the United States had entered into a guerilla war. Was he and his band of outsiders going to take on the American military? He did not even have the same training as the insurgents who he admired.

I wanted Howard to be honest with me. I wanted him to come out of the television and explain what had actually happened. I kept thinking that I needed the courage to attain his confidence. He looked as if no one could threaten his leadership. I would have to learn from his lessons.

I had prepared my questions. I wanted Howard to be a cooperative interview. But I realized that would not be enough. I had given so much of myself to him. He was an influence. I wanted to know how he had found the inspiration to carry on the movement to the next step.

I could admit that practical strategies had their own drawback. It was often easy to overestimate the power of the enemy. I don't think that this was the basis for my skepticism. Howard may have started from the right place. He saw something that was wrong. But he wanted to put himself in the middle of everything. He exaggerated the importance of his own contribution.

I was facing this crisis of leadership. This seemed to be one of the key questions in history. This went beyond Moses leading his people in the desert. The clarity originated the social disorder which inspired the individual. The people depended on an accurate assessment of events. The right leader was shaped by this awareness. Some might question whether such a definition was an imposition, but that did not diminish the importance of these historical forces. The individual would first have to discern these patterns in his immediate surroundings. From there, he could assert his analysis.

Where did he progress from an understanding of individual action to a recognition of a common pattern of social influence. Such an awareness did not just originate in his own viewpoint. Instead, these forces seemed to coalesce and lead him to his knowledge.

Howard had done very well in trying to represent this process. However, he seemed to manipulate the depiction to suit his purpose. He could later apologize for his shortcomings. But this as all about him. History became part of this cathartic experience, which expressed his own personal longings. He was not the only one who seemed well-suited for this grandstanding. He could lament the tragedies that occurred because of his own actions. But everything seemed all to personal in his narrative. Even in admitting fault, he still wanted to act as his voice remained preeminent. That as not how it worked. And it didn't work any different for his detractors, who were even less apt to admit their own faults. They were class collaborators. And he was doing his best to chart his own course.

He may have been right about the significance of the historical moment. But his assessment was self-serving. It did not cease the worst examples of state imperialism. And it did not address the more important social issues, which gave propelled him into the spotlight. How

had he gotten it all so wrong?

If I analyzed his language, I had a better understanding of what was the problem. He was creating this cartoonish view of the events. He was doing his best to make the connection between the individual cogs and the war machine. But he acted as if his enemies were all parts of this obscure machine. Those who were not immediately ceding to his logic, were lumped in with those who were acting in a more authoritarian way.

He questioned the ability of the people to address a host of abuses. On this basis, he was able to unleash his monster opposition. His rhetoric was already warlike. He was acting as if the same rules of engagement applied in cities as were being used in America's imperial conflicts. This was not to say that the military might was not being felt at home. But there was some care to preserve some of the social norms which supported the dominant culture. If he was ready to declare war, he needed to be prepared for the brunt of that might. While the areas of urban neglect had faced military occupation, he barely had strategy to counter this aggression.

"What did you think was going to happen once the police moved in? What was your plan? Where did you work to ground the movement in a more popular foundation? You were just trying to string together one happening with another. And you ended up feeding your own paranoia about the state. And the repressive forces gave you the excuse which you wanted."

Did he have an answer for any of the serious strategic questions faced by the movement? He couldn't claim that everything that followed was accidental. And he hardly prepared for what was happening.

Inevitably, he was providing a necessary safety valve on the protests. There was a clear opportunity to carry community satisfaction to a level of collective action. He did what he could to advance the insurgency. Here, Howard was more attuned to the spectacle of the event.

"It is up to you to recognize how you have overestimated your position. The failure of electoral politics did not provide the basis to occupy buildings. That only left you exposed to the very oppressive forces, which you denounce."

"The police have demonstrated their intent."

"You are making them seem more powerful than they are. You have to learn how to break their legitimacy."

"And how do propose that I do that."

"We are ready to declare victory. Our forces have made significant advances. We have made common cause with other revolutionary leaders. We are ready to do what is necessary to maintain power. We need to confront all forms of oppression."

I had loads of documents, which revealed the further intent of Howard and his allies. These originally seemed to be the source of such appealing arguments. I felt ready to make the leap.

"The message is only lost if it does not have enough redundancy to overcome the noise."

- "The message is always going to use noise as a carrier."
- "It's six of one, half dozen of the other."
- "Perhaps, but it can be ignored. If you are going to be prepared for the calm."
- "The message is already understood. I am the calm and the silence."
- "I am very afraid of the emergence of such irrationalism. That only made me want to get away."

- "How would you have reacted if the revolutionaries had actually espoused a working class position? Would the presence of such a foundation have frightened you."
 - "I am afraid of the mob."
- "Does a mass movement frighten? Is there a political understanding which is not in your books? Where is any of this headed?"
 - "That was what I was saying?"
- "You were not afraid of the mistakes exhibited by the movement. You feared the actual opposition to a repressive regime. You had pledged your allegiance to that organization."
 - "You are repeating the same comments directed against the school administration."
 - "Can you say that your analysis of the system was accurate?"
 - "The government had engaged in systematic oppression."
 - "So you decided that you were going personally punish the system."
- "I was seeking to create a revolutionary movement. I was working to create support for the movement."
 - "You only made people more suspicious of your motives."
 - "I am calling out imperialism for what it is."

You never intended to build a mass movement. That would have threatened your own position. There were people who were sympathetic with your basic aims, the redistribution of income and the empowerment of the individual. But you never acknowledged their support. You did not exploit the radical forces available. Nowhere did you put any pressure on the dominant forces controlling society. You never analyzed the basis of their power. You acted as if they had committed a coup, and you were going to oppose them with your own military unit. You spoke as if you were in the midst of an insurrection.

- "You are not going to meet him."
- "What are you going to do about it?"
- "If you go see him, I don't want you coming back to the house."
- "You can't do that. I live here."
- "You don't work. I pay all the bills."
- "You can't make me act like that."
- "He is influencing you to do strange things."
- "I am not being influence to do anything."
- "Do you want to start living your own life?"
- "Are you really telling me that my private life is going to be starting a revolution?"
- "You have to make a first step."
- "And what happens if I make that first step?"
- "How would you act if your picture was on the front page of the paper?"
- "I would hope that my parents wouldn't look at me."
- "Are you doing all this just to shock your parents?"
- "What are you asking me?"
- "Maybe, if you shock your parents, you can demonstrate to yourself that you are free."
 - "I am free no matter what I do."
 - "Then why don't you do something which shows a little thought on your part."
 - "I do what makes me feel good. I am good at seeing that for myself."

- "You are a tease."
- "Do you think that you are the only one who says that to me?"
- "What is your hope?"
- "Do you think that you can be honest with yourself?"
- "Howard, do you think that you can ever be honest with yourself?"
- "You are offering revolution as some kind of communion. What am I supposed to make of that?"
 - "You are such an insufferable moralist."
 - "Your lover is my best friends."
 - "What does that make us? Almost lovers."
 - "You are an opportunist."
 - "And you?"
 - "I am going to give my life for this."
 - "Which life? You have nine!"
 - "I have ten."

And in that dark night, you heard a voice which guided you to make a fateful journey.

- "You want to believe that fating. What does the number 1828 mean?"
- "What are you talking about?"
- *"18281828?"*
- "This is a place of rest!"
- "What are you doing over there?"
- "I am going over your case. These are questions of guilt and innocence!"
- "I did nothing wrong. I do not recognize your authority to rule over me."
- "You cannot make a mockery out of this courtroom."
- "I will make a joke about it. And your actions will all be overturned on appeal."
- "You are really wasting my time."
- "That is all that I have. I can send you back to jail."
- "I am honored to serve more time in jail. You can cage me, but you cannot silence my lovely song."
 - "You are a joke. There is no song."
 - "You are tone deaf."
 - "Steven, you really need to have a better understanding of historical events."
- "These events are intersections of other events. And I am keeping track of all the threads. There are these points of emergence. This is all part of the intent of the dominant class."
 - "That sounds like Howard."
- "I am trying to escape his influence. Everything is so strident. When he needs to be dramatic, the volume is already so high that nothing can be heard."
 - "How do you propose to tone it down?"
 - "If you were in my situation, you would have done what I did."
- "You turned politics into theater. And you played for an eager audience. But the people who you needed to reach thought that you were a clown."
 - "They feared me."
 - "Good. They feared you. Everything was written in big letters. There were no reasoned

arguments. People watched for a while. Then they changed the station."

"They were lulled by television."

"Where do you make your entrance? Do you want a laugh track? Or do you want tragic music?"

"There is a moment when the individual makes a connection to the concrete matter which motivates mankind."

"The material which connects you to the basic structure of the universe."

"Exaggeration."

"What are you talking about?"

"What are you talking about?"

"You are losing your focus."

Howard was not reassuring. When he tried to explain his beliefs, it only made me more certain of what I wanted. I wondered why I could not give myself the push that I needed. Did my disappointment with Howard prevent me from realizing my own potential? I hoped for more.

The pleasure road hardly seemed to have the radical appeal. But I needed something to counter Howard's apology. I wanted something more substantial. I imagined that these unique powers could bubble up from deep in our nature. Howard seemed to imply a potent inspiration.

"There are people who depend on you."

"What is that supposed to mean? I am not Moses leading you through the desert."

"Where does that come from?"

"I cannot offer myself as a savior."

"There is only one, Howard."

"Steven, you are always so coy when it comes to looking at anything serious."

"I am not going to give you the satisfaction. I am examining your leadership. You never took the circumstances that seriously."

"I was arrested. I was expelled from the university. Are you willing to risk for what you believe?"

"It is not about the risk, Howard. Is there something worthy risking for."

"But you do have to assume a risk if there is going to be some kind of political change."

"That is how you try to redeem what you've done in the past. You simply walked around the changes which needed to be made. And you used your arrest to indicate that the system was not willing to listen to your arguments. You never finished what you needed to do. So you substituted all this anger for what was needed."

"Some people do have a grasp."

"What are you saying by that? I don't feel as if I can help you see what is needed."

"Steven, you offer such brilliant critique from the sidelines."

"You sidelined a whole movement, which put its faith in you."

"The system was so repressive that it did not allow us to recognize what needed to be done."

"So you acted to protect your privilege."

"You don't know what it's like in the trenches."

"You created trenches before you had the forces to fill them. That does not lead to an

advanced political consciousness. You had not idea about the necessary preparation. Every successful movement has engaged in analysis and education."

"We did that."

"Your perspective for action moved far ahead of your historical awareness. You did not educate your allies. You went ahead with your plans, and they did not lead to significant change in the system. Your opponents became more entrenched."

"We created the inspiration for looking at society in a new way. People changed their lifestyles. It was the beginning of a major social revolution."

"You created a new elite. And you left us out in the cold."

"You are being so dramatic. I planted a seed."

"You confused us all. You seemed to be reporting from the front lines. But you were too deep in it to do much good."

"You don't know."

"Oh, I do. I have to know. I was one of the people who looked to you for guidance. I watched the newsreels. I read the speeches. If you can't convince me, then who are your followers? And that is all part of the disappointment."

"You need to understand better. You are simply reacting from your own privileged position,. And you are blaming me for things that you could never do yourself."

"There were loads of kids who were impressed by your actions. But you had little idea how to guide others."

"I admit my mistakes."

"You are not admitting to anything. You would do the same thing if you had the chance. You have no idea how to mobilize a social revolution. You are ready to pull the trigger before there is any movement. And you exploit the existing suffering for your own benefit. I am trying to paint a picture for you. You are no more observant now than you were."

"You did not see the struggle in the neighborhood."

"Other people were sympathetic. But you needed a broader mass movement. Your analysis of the Chicago events only contributed to your adventuresomeness. This was not a school project. You were not going to get promoted because you did extra work."

"That is condescending."

Howard wanted to review the past on his terms. I couldn't express my own frustration. He seemed resistant to hearing about the actual roots of his betrayal. He did not grasp how his radicalism was only a distraction. This was not about entertainment. He lacked powerful tools to review his own actions. He did not want to admit to such a possible insight.

Howard had such a flair, which he derived from his militant allies. He acted as if he was bringing sophistication to their rebellion. It only made it all the more misdirected. It also created this macho pressure for Howard to take it further. If his allies were ready to pick up guns, he needed to take his movement underground. That only made the motives more obscure. It also made it more incumbent on Howard to figure out where he had gone astray.

Howard had veered off the deep end when he got started. He was already worsening the situation. He took his cue from other interventions around the world. And his actions were significant for other activists. That hardly meant that his method was effective.

There were occasions when the participants were able to ground their actions deeper in

theory. This was one of his shortcomings. Even in these other situations, there was this same acceleration of the historical process. This only made people more disorientation.

Could anything be learned from Howard's example. Was this a perfect template for Revolutionary Aims? There were ideal candidates who found Howard's journey appealing. They could play this story on a television set. If the new celebrities achieved a notoriety, they believed that this could provide the means to transform the society.

Was Revolutionary Aims offered the means for change? Or did it share the same motives with reality television? The dating service taught people how to make crafty associations which helped them to pad their bank accounts.

Howard was able to distill the revolutionary zeal into a set of formalized gestures. The demands became amorphous. People could rail against capitalism while trying to reconcile themselves to a resistant system. This might as well have been a handbook to success in the modern world. It was the next step beyond marketing Che t-shirts. There was a general sympathy with the poor. But the clients only wanted someone to assuage their guilty consciences. Revolutionary Aims made its appeals.

The machine determined that Becca would provide the best match for you. This determination was based on your habits and lifestyle. You and Becca were searching for the same thing. It could be best described in the plaintive lyric of a song. This was the feeling of loss and deep longing.

"What are you doing to yourself?"

"I am preparing my body for the coming political and social changes."

"This is hardly the basis for real friendship. You cannot believe the lies of the machine."

"We are doing our best."

You knew that you looked glorious. You had taken all the precautions that you needed, and the shine of your being was reflected at every point in your surroundings.
